



PROTOCOL – PHARMACY

Our pharmacy will dispense the following scripts:

- Amoxicillin - 500mg (#21) 1 TID x 7D
- Clindamycin - 300 mg (#21-1) 1 TID x 7D
- Amoxicillin – 500 mg (#30) 1 TID x 10D
- Clindamycin – 300 mg (#30) 1 TID x 10D
- Ibuprofen - 400mg (#28) 1-2Q 4-6 prn pain
- Acetaminophen – 325 mg (#28) 1-2Q 4-6 prn pain
- Ibuprofen liquid – 100 mg/5ml

Pharmacy will have 6 sets of record-keeping sheets for each of the scripts listed above:

- i.e. 1 set will say pre-med amoxicillin on the top.
- Each of these sheets will have columns which list the Rx number, patient's name, Dr's name, patient's signature and the dispensing doctor's signature.
- An ambassador must escort a patient to the pharmacy department and hand the tx sheet with the script to a volunteer.
- The volunteer will write the appropriate information in the first 2 columns of the record keeping sheets and ask a dentist to counsel the patient.
- The volunteer will also write the same information on a label and adhere it to the appropriate vial.
- The dentist will dispense the prescribed med(s) to the patient and sign the record-keeping form.
- Each of the above 8 prescriptions will have a special marking on the top of its vial and will be stored in separate boxes.
- Labels will be pre-printed and lines left for the Rx#, date, patient's name, DOB, address, phone number, and prescribing doctor.
